

Memphis Motion and "The Best of Both Worlds" Memphis and Nashville

August 9 – 15, 2010

Day 1 – Monday, August 9 – Brantford – Cincinnati (D)

Motor Coach Company - Bus A - picks up in Brantford/Woodstock/London/Windsor

We will travel to Cincinnati, stopping for lunch en route and coffee breaks as well. Entertainment on board the coach, with the fabulous members of "Memphis Motion" your hosts for the entire tour! Proceed to our full service Holiday Inn, North Cincinnati (or similar). Dinner buffet upon arrival including live entertainment after dinner. Dinner buffet. Entertainment by Memphis Motion and the Tribute Artists on board.

Day 2 – Tuesday, August 10 – Cincinnati, Ohio - Cincinnati – Nashville, TN (B)

Breakfast buffet in the hotel (included). Trivia contests, impersonation games, Elvis Videos and CD's, karaoke, etc. along the route. Arrive at your downtown Nashville Hotel. Located near all the night life, the hotel this year allows group members to explore downtown Nashville.

Day 3 – Wednesday, Aug. 11 – Nashville – (B, L)

Breakfast. Morning visit to the famous recording studio, [RCA Studio B](#) – Record a group song and receive a copy of your recording at this famous studio where Elvis recorded many of his biggest hits. Continue to downtown for **lunch** and dancing at the Wildhorse Saloon. Performance by Memphis Motion in the Atrium of the [Country Music Hall of Fame](#) in downtown Nashville. We then go up the street to the [Musicians Hall of Fame](#) where Elvis is honoured amongst his peers, as being amongst the greatest musical talents to appear in this Century. Return to the hotel in downtown Nashville.

Day 4 – Thursday, Aug. 12 – Nashville - Memphis (B)

Breakfast in the hotel before departing for Memphis. Arriving around lunch time, the group will have a visit to Beale Street where group members can explore and buy their own lunch. We then check in to our hotel near downtown Memphis, where the group will overnight. Tonight the [Ultimate Elvis Tribute Artists Contest Finals](#) (link shows 2009 schedule) takes place so the group will have tickets to go to this performance to cheer on their favourite Tribute Artist. Return to the hotel for overnight and free time.

Day 5 – Fri., Aug. 13 – Memphis (B)

Breakfast in the hotel. Today the program begins at 10:00 with the group proceeding to the **Peabody hotel** in time to line up for the "marching of the ducks" at 11:00 through the lobby of the hotel. Those who have seen this before have free time to shop in the mall next to the hotel or to get souvenirs on Beale Street. Lunch on your own at Graceland. The group will participate in the [Platinum tour of Graceland](#). Scheduled tours are arranged for this tour. In the evening there will be a [Celebration Concert](#) (link shows 2009 Schedule) of the life of Elvis. Each year a different period of his life is featured in this concert taking place at the Canon Centre in downtown Memphis. Free time afterwards or to the hotel downtown Memphis.

Day 6 – Sat., Aug. 14 – Memphis – Louisville (B, L)

Breakfast in the hotel. We depart Memphis today, lunch stop along the way (included) and then continue to [Louisville](#). Upon arrival at our downtown hotel, the group will have free time in the downtown entertainment and shopping district. Those interested can take the bus across the Ohio River into Indiana to gamble at the [Golden Horseshoe Casino](#) in Elizabeth Indiana, a short distance from Louisville. Return to the hotel after 3 hours for gambling at the Casino. Dinner on your own. Overnight in Louisville, Kentucky.

Day 7 – Sun., Aug. 15 – Louisville, Kentucky – Toledo, Ohio – Windsor/Brantford (B)

Breakfast in the hotel (included). Check out of Galt Inn and travel by motor coach to through Ohio to Michigan with stops along the way for lunch and coffee stops (on your own) as needed. Drop off guests in Windsor, London, Woodstock, Brantford and Cambridge.
